CADS Chauffeur Level 1



A person who has completed the CADS Chauffeur training module is able to operate a TandemSki mechanically (ascent, descent, and all adjustments) and skilled at driving it. The chauffeur accompanies all disabled people with a TandemSki on groomed slopes from beginner to expert.

These requirements represent the minimum standards demanded of volunteers, candidates, and future instructors wishing to obtain the CADS Chauffeur certification.

The Chauffeur certification process is offered as a complete course over 4 days. To receive CADS Chauffeur Level 1 certification, all stages of the module must be completed, including online training.

Certification requirements are based on knowledge and application of:

- The teaching module,
- The certification level and requirements,
- People with disabilities,
- Safe handling of students,
- Pedagogical teaching skills,
- Pre-operational procedures,
- Boarding and disembarking procedures,
- Skills associated with the various mandatory maneuvers with the equipment.



Chauffeur Course Conductor

The requirements set out for this CADS level represent the minimum standards demanded of chauffeur candidates wishing to obtain the CADS Chauffeur Course Conductor level.

The certification procedure to obtain the Course Conductor level is offered as a complete course over 4 days.

Additional Prerequisites

1. CADS complete certification
2. CADS Level 1 Chauffeur certification
3. Participate in 5 (60 minute) online training sessions.
